As you know, prior to competing in any competition sponsored by USA Track & Field, all participants sign a liability waiver, which Ms. Brooks did prior to the 2021 Trials in Eugene, Oregon. USA Track & Field makes the health and safety of its athletes its top priority at any event.

However, as with any athletic competition, there are risks inherent in participation, and USA Track & Field cannot be legally responsible for injuries that occur in the course of those competitions. Accordingly, should this claim get into litigation, USA Track & Field will rely on the waiver as one of its defenses.

USA Track & Field does continue to be interested in resolving this claim without the need for litigation. Please advise as to your client's position.
